THE BASICS BOX DUES

Approximately 20% of the Troop's operating income comes from the weekly dues paid by each scout. The amount collected is determined by the Troop Committee. Presently, the amount is \$.50 per week. Your Scout is responsible to keep his dues current. The patrol leaders collect the dues from their patrol members and turn it over to the Troop scribe. Having proper change is a help, or dues may be prepaid at any time. Records are kept to insure proper credit to each Scout's dues account within his patrol. Dues not only provide for the financial stability of the Troop, but help your Scout realize that he has an obligation to contribute financially to an organization

in which he participates and reaps the benefits of the Troop's success. For this reason, dues should come from your Scout's own resources. Allowance and earned income are excellent sources for your scout. Dues may not be paid from the Scout Account dept in the Troop treasury. They should get it the old fashioned way, let them earn it!

Dues are monitored by the Scoutmaster. Scouts owing more than \$5.00 will be contacted. Participation on trips and advancement in rank may be restricted if dues are owed.
