Scouts always do things with "BUDDIES", never alone! 2. Scouts never tent alone or with an adult (except with a scout's parent) 3. All Scouting activities require two leaders. This includes regular scout meetings and side trips on outings. 4. Leaders and adults are not permitted to be intoxicated or consume alcoholic beverages while leading or attending a Troop function. 	<p>We require that all Troop 152 leaders attend our Council's Youth Protection Program seminars. Parents are also welcome to attend. Ask our Scoutmaster for the schedule of presentations.</p> <p>If you have any suspicions or concerns about reports of child abuse within our Troop, please contact any of the Troop leaders or committee members, and also contact the Council's chief executive.</p>
