SUMMER CAMP SWIM TEST!

A pre-camp swim test will be offered for scouts attending summer camp, at the North Penn High School swimming pool, Thursday, July 15 Be there at 7:00 PM with your swim suit on. Qualify your swimming skills here and avoid the crowds at summer camp. There are three swimming skill levels: Swimmer – able to swim 75 yards free style, 25 yards of elementary back stroke, and float on your back for 1 minute; Beginner – able to swim 50 yards free style; and non-swimmer. Camp will offer swimming instructions for those not able to achieve a swimmer rating. You can take the test as many times as you like at camp.

BASICS BOX EMERGENCY PHONE CONTACTS

Emergency phone number contacts are critical when your scout is attending a scouting function. Please keep the leaders informed as to where you will be and how you can be reached while your scout is attending a troop 152 function.

Scout leaders are responsible to assess your scout's need for medical assistance. In the event of a medical emergency, the leaders will get your scout to a hospital. Hospital medical

professionals will not treat your scout unless a family member has been consulted, even if a consent signature is on their BSA medical form. If you or another family member cannot be reached, treatment will be delayed.

This delay can be agonizing for a scout, and the Scout leaders who must accompany him to the hospital. So here are some tips to keep in mind when your scout is out and about with the troop.

- Make sure emergency contact phone numbers are listed on trip permission slips and on your scout's BSA medical form.
- Keep a pager or cell phone with you and give us the numbers
- Use answering machines and check them often during the outing
- List an alternate family member and phone number and let them know where you can be reached.


