Do you realize there are 126 merit badges currently offered by BSA? I have to believe there is a merit badge for everyone! This includes merit badges offered for a limited time in 2010, including Tracking and Carpentry. A number of scouts in the troop have earned these this year. The distinction of the least awarded badge in BSA history belongs to the Inventing merit badge. Only 10 scouts ever earned it and it was discontinued in 1915. However, in June 2010 it was brought back with new and improved requirements. Unlike the old badge, scouts earning the badge won't be required to apply for and receive a US patent on an invention!

Some merit badges that may interest you are Electricity, Chemistry, Backpacking and Gardening. I know for a fact that there are merit badge counselors in Troop 152 for each of these. If you know the name of the Gardening merit badge counselor please see me ASAP (or at least before the first frost!)

I would like to give a big scout thank you to Mr. Davey for organizing an awesome trip to the Delaware water gap in October. The weather was perfect and the campground, which the troop had never visited before, was first-rate.

I am always looking for opportunities to keep the older scouts in the troop engaged in scouting activities. 
2010 WREATH SALE !!!

With our wreath and popcorn sale looming in full swing, a review of the Scout Accounts is in order. All profits from our fund raisers are credited to the Troop's general fund.

A portion of each scout's contribution from the wreath amd popcorn sales and any Escript credits, submitted are tracked as account points. The troop's committee determines the number of points to be credited for each contribution.

Don't forget to use these points to pay for troop activities or purchasing Scouting related clothing or camping equipment. Your scout's account point balance is available at any regular Scout Meeting. When registering for any troop activity, request payment to be taken from the scout account.

Credit for trips will be made from the troop treasury, provided the scout account balance is sufficient to cover the expense.
