The rain slackened we retrieved our gear, put our tarps in the tents and went to sleep in dry sleeping bags and cloths.

Friday Mr. Nagele took us all tubing and we were all soaked again. It was comical to watch the boys hold on for dear life one minute and the next were giving the thumbs up to go faster. As I helped each scout back on to the boat the repeated statement was "That was great can I do it again?" And Saturday we all did it again in the rain.

Two things were learned on this trip.

The boys learned if they do things the right way, setting up their tents and keeping their gear dry the weather doesn't matter.

For me it really sank in why so many of our leaders are still here even after their boys have aged out of scouts. I hope we have many more trips like this one and you join us on some of them.
