And I tell them to do what they think they can't. It is my intension to be behind the scouts and give them words of encouragement and on occasion a preverbal "kick in the pants" to help them "Be Prepare" to do (what they will see as) the impossible.



## 2015 RECHARTER

Troop Re-charter for 2015 is in full swing. EVERY Scout and Scouter must re-register with Troop 152 for 2015. Registration forms and fees are due no later than *November 11, 2014*. # THE BASICS BOX SCOUT ACCOUNTS



With our wreath sale looming in full swing, a review of the Scout Accounts is in order. All profits from our fund raisers are credited to the Troop's general fund.

A portion of each scout's contribution from the wreath sales and any Escript credits, submitted are tracked as account points. The troop's committee determines the number of points to be credited for each contribution.

Don't forget to use these points to pay for troop activities or purchasing Scouting related clothing or camping equipment.

Your scout's account point balance is available at any regular Scout Meeting. When registering for any troop activity, request payment to be taken from the scout account.

Credit for trips will be made from the troop treasury, provided the scout account balance is sufficient to cover the expense.


