PENNSYLVANIA CHILD ABUSE LAW

Laws recently passed by the State Legislature in Harrisburg require all adults, paid or volunteer, in direct charge of children, to complete a PA State Criminal Record Clearance, a PA State Child Abuse Clearance, and either an FBI clearance with finger prints or an FBI disclosure for volunteers affirming that volunteers have lived in PA for 10 years or more. All adults attending Troop 152 activities must complete these requirements by Dec 31, 2015. Upload them to BSA if you are a registered leader.
