We need your sales count in **October**, to know how many wreaths to order. Don't let down your valued customers. Wreaths will be \$18 this year. Wreath stands are \$2. Each scout is required to sell 12 wreaths. They will earn \$2 per wreath sold in their scout account. December is quickly approaching, and it is once again time to begin planning this year's wreath sale. This is the Troop's one and only fund raising project, and provides the Troop with the largest part of its operating funds.

In addition, the wreath sale provides an opportunity for each Scout to build up points in their Scout Account to use towards the expense of scouting activities.

For those new to the troop, this fund raiser is about as painless as they get. The wreaths really sell themselves. They are an excellent buy, attractive,

and hardy. Once you get a customer, repeat sales are a snap.

Each scout is expected to sell 12 wreaths. Profits from the sale are split between the Troop's general fund and your Scout's Account. The Troop Committee will be deciding the details on price and the percentage split offered at their September meeting.


