BASICS BOX WEST POINT FOUNDATION

All Scouting units are required to be represented by a sponsoring organization. Troop 152 was solidly sponsored by the Upper Gwynedd Lions Club for decades. The Lions Club funded the construction of the Upper Gwynedd Community Building, where Pack 152 and Troop 152 hold their weekly meetings. This building was donated to Upper Gwynedd Township with the agreement that the Scouting organizations had priority for scheduling their meetings. The Upper Gwynedd Lions Club unfortunately disbanded and dissolved in July of 2014, with the passing of Jim Alago.

In lieu of a search for a new non-profit organization to sponsor the troop, a group of concerned citizens decided to form a non-profit organization to sponsor Pack 152 and Troop 152. This new organization is the West Point Foundation. The Foundation held its first official meeting on July 29, 2014, and subsequently obtained 501(C)(3) federal and state designation as a non-profit organization. The Foundation's mission statement is **to provide youth with the** opportunity to learn life skills and leadership qualities in a safe, but interesting environment.
