 - Official BSA Shirt with Green numbers & epilates
 - o Troop Hat
 - O Merit Badge Sash / Order of Arrow Sash (special occasions)
- CLASS B
- Official BSA Trousers or Shorts
- o Official BSA Socks
- Official BSA Belt
 Troop RED T-Shirt
- Troop RED 7Troop Hat

Class "A" uniforms are worn to all official BSA meetings and whenever the Troop travels, also for scoutmaster conferences and Board of Reviews for rank advancement.

Special ceremonies and meetings, such as Eagle Ceremonies, Family Night meetings, and OA functions, are occasions to include the dress sashes. Our troop does not require a neckerchief.

Class "B" uniforms may be worn to Troop meetings during the summer months, generally June through September. The scoutmaster will announce when Class B uniforms are permitted. The Troop's Hat and T-Shirt are available for purchase at any meeting.
