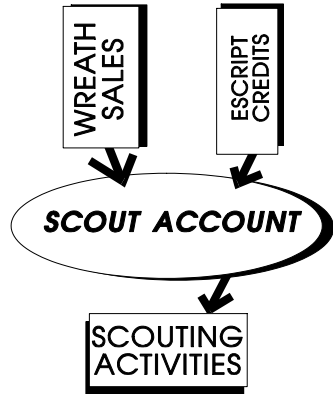
SCOUTING FOR FOOD

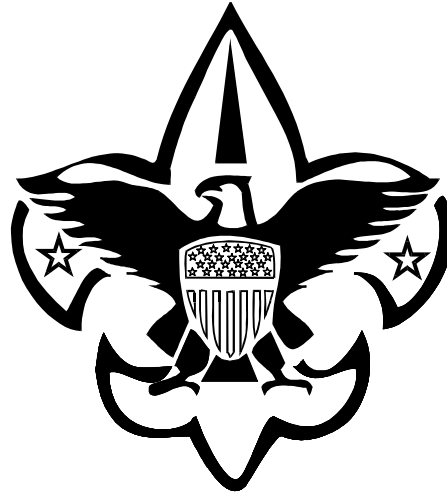
