Emergency phone number contacts are critical when your scout is attending a scouting function. Please keep the leaders informed at where you will be and how you can be reached while your scout is attending a troop 152 function. Scout leaders are responsible to assess your scout's need for medical assistance. In the event of a medical emergency, the leaders wi get your scout to a hospital. Hospital medical	 Professionals will not treat your scout unless a family member has been consulted, even if a consent signature is on their BSA medical form. If you or another family member cannot be reached, treatment will be delayed. This delay can be agonizing for a scout, and the Scout leaders who must accompany him to the hospital. So here are some tips to keep in mind when your scout is out and about with the troop. Make sure emergency contact pho numbers are listed on trip permises slips and on your scout's BSA medical form. Keep a pager or cell phone with y give us the numbers Use answering machines and cheat them often during the outing List an alternate family member and let them know you can be reached.
