### SCOUTMASTER'S CORNER

Each year I find it amazing that the buildup to longer days in the summer seems take so long, but the return to early evening darkness seems to happen so fast! September was a busy month with the end of summer vacations and the start of school. The Scouts were busy working on advancements and working on preparation for October's Cub-o-ree.

Late in the month we headed out on a Scout favorite trip, the Bloomsburg Fair! We were able to camp at BSA Camp Lavigne close to both Bloomsburg and Rickets Glen State Park. On Saturday morning we heeded to Rickets Glen for a hike. Splitting in to two groups, we both started at the Glens Lot Trailhead parking lot on Route 118. The one group started their hike downhill on the Evergreen Trail with their intent of gaining over 1000 feet in elevation during their hike to the top of the park. This 1000-foot gain goal is part of a requirement of the Camping Merit badge. They then returned uphill following the Old Bulldozer Road Trail to the Lake Leigh Dam. In returning to the parking lot the followed the eastern branch of the Falls trail through Glen Leigh to Waters Meeting and on to the parking lot recording close to eight miles for the day. The other group headed directly up the Falls Trail through Waters Meet and up the eastern branch of the Falls trail through Glen Leigh. After a lunch break, they headed west across the Highland trail to the Lake Rose Trailhead.

We all met up the Glen Lot trailhead parking and returned to Camp Lavigne for a quick refresh and headed out for the Bloomsburg Fair. Unfortunately, on this opening weekend of the Fair and we had gotten a later start than planned, so we sat in traffic for quite while before we made it to the Fair. We made the most of our time at the fair and left with fuller stomachs and emptier wallets.

We wrapped up the month with our Fall family night and court of Honor. Scouts received the merit badges and other awards they earned from summer camp and work done on their own. We also kicked off our Christmas Wreath sales which runs through late October.

Coming up next in October is the General Nash Cub-O-Ree. We will be 'edutaining' the Cub Scouts with 'under the sea' themed activities. This is an "all hands-on-deck" event, so please help out where you are able. Later in October we will be heading out for a day hike to the Pinnacle near Hamburg, PA.

### WREATH SALE


